

Privacy Policy

Welcome to Mixl! This privacy policy (“Privacy Policy”) is to help you understand what information we collect, how we use it, how it may be shared and what choices and rights you have with respect to your information. This Privacy Policy governs the website and other digital products and services (collectively, “Services”) offered by Gloqal, Inc., a Delaware corporation (“Gloqal,” “we,” “us,” or “our”). Additionally, our [Terms of Service](#) are incorporated by reference into this Privacy Policy.

For your convenience, the following is an overview of the various sections of this Privacy Policy. This overview merely summarizes terms of the Privacy Policy, however, and is qualified in its entirety by reference to the Privacy Policy itself. We're glad you're here!

Overview

1. **Your Acceptance of our Collection of Certain Information** – We will collect information from you from various sources including, for example, from you directly, automatically while you are using the Services, or from other third party sources.
2. **Your Acceptance of our Use of Your Information** – You acknowledge that we will use your information to deliver, support, improve the Services, and to offer you customized content, for example, based on your interests and content you share.
3. **Your Acceptance of Our Sharing of Your Information** – We will share your information mostly in order to provide better Services to you, but may also share your information with our affiliated entities or when we believe it is required by law.
4. **Your Eligibility to Use the Services** – Our Services are intended for users who are 18 years or older.
5. **Your Rights to Access and Modify your Information** – You may contact us to access your information that we have in our files or to ask us that we modify such information.
6. **Your Acceptance to the Changes of this Privacy Policy** - We may revise this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you of any material changes. Your continued use of the Services will constitute your acceptance to these changes.

Information We Collect

When you use the Services, we collect information that you provide us directly or automatically. We also may collect information about you from third parties or that is publicly available.

Information that you provide us

Profile Information

Information that we collect in the course of your use of our Services is used to create your user or business profile and to enable you to use the Services. You can edit and customize the information in your profile by going to your account and profile settings. If you provide us with profile information and you do not see a visibility setting, that information is public.

Content you Provide

When you use the Services, you may voluntarily provide us with additional information, such as your name, email address, profile picture for avatar, and communications between you and other users that occur on or through our Services.

Communications with Gloqal

If you contact Gloqal, either through our online platform, e-mail or otherwise, we may keep your message, e-mail address and contact information to respond to your request.

Information that we collect automatically

Log Data

When you use the Services, our servers automatically record information (“Log Data”), including information that your browser sends whenever you visit a website. This log data may include your IP address, the address of the web pages you visited that had GLO features, browser type and settings, the date and time of your request, how you used the Services, and cookie data.

Session Content

When you use the Services to connect with others via GLO’s platform, our servers automatically save data from conversations occurring to ensure compliance with GLO community guidelines and for legitimate business purposes. We may share some of this information with the website where you were using our Services, and with technology vendors who are strictly necessary for our Services to function.

Cookie Data

Depending on how you are accessing the Services, we may use “cookies” (a small text file sent by your computer each time you visit our Services, unique to your GLO account or your browser) or similar technologies to record Log Data. When we use cookies, we may use “session” cookies (that last until you close your browser) or “persistent” cookies (that last until you or your browser delete them). You can set your browser to refuse to accept cookies. However, if you choose to refuse cookies, some features of the Services may not function properly.

Device Information

In addition to Log Data, we may also collect information about the device on which you are using the Services, including what type of device it is, what operating system you are using, device settings, unique device identifiers, and crash data. Whether we collect some or all of this information often depends on what type of device you’re using and its settings.

Do Not Track

Your browser may support a “Do Not Track” option that can be selected in your browser settings, which sends a signal to websites you visit informing them that you do not want certain information

about your visit to be collected. At this time we do not respond to browser “Do Not Track” signals, as we await the work of interested stakeholders and others to develop standards for how such signals should be interpreted.

Analytics and Usage

We use data analytics and work with certain third party service providers, such as Google Analytics, to help us understand and improve the use of our Services, and to provide business value to our partners. These third party service providers may collect information sent by your device as part of a web page request, such as cookies or your IP address. Third party ad partners may also share information with us to help us measure and tailor ads.

Information From Other Services

Information from Other Services

You may give us permission to access your information in other services. For example, you may link one or more of your social media accounts to the Services, which allows us to obtain information from those accounts (such as your friends or contacts). The information we obtain from those services depends on your settings and their privacy policies.

How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to deliver, support and improve the Services. We also use the information we collect to offer you customized content, for example, based on your interests and content you post. We also use your information to notify you about updates to the Services, monitor and test the Services, remember your login information, and contact you for marketing purposes.

When We Share Your Information

We may share your information with third parties from time to time, including:

- *Agents, Contractors and Service Providers.* We may share your information with our agents, contractors or other service providers as needed to carry out the performance and functionality of the Services, fulfill your requests for authorized transactions, or provide user support.
- *Analytics and Usage.* We may share user information in the aggregate with third parties, such as our partner businesses.
- *Affiliated Entities.* We may share information from or about you with subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under common control with GLO, in which case, we require them to honor this Privacy Policy.
- *Business Transfers.* If we are acquired by or merged with another entity, if substantially all of our assets are transferred to another company, or as part of a bankruptcy proceeding, we may transfer the information we have collected about you to the acquiring company.
- *Investigations.* We may investigate and disclose information from or about you, as permitted by applicable law, if we have a good faith belief that such investigation or disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with legal process and law enforcement

instructions and orders, such as a search warrant, subpoena, statute, judicial proceeding, or other legal process served on us, helpful to prevent, investigate, or identify possible wrongdoing in connection with the Services, or helpful to protect our rights, reputation, property, or that of our users, subsidiaries, or the public.

Children

This Service is intended for adults and is not directed to children under 18. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 18. If you learn that a child has provided us with personal information without parental consent, please contact us immediately at hello@gloqal.co. and we will take steps to remove such information and terminate the child's account.
